The Government, in exercise of the power conferred on them by section 3 of the Maritime Jurisdiction (Amendment) Act, 1964 (No. 32 of 1964), hereby order as follows:

- 1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Maritime Jurisdiction (Amendment) Act, 1964 (Specified States) (Amendment) Order, 1967.
