Scientific studies have proven that the Philippines is the epicenter of marine biodiversity. A geographical information system analysis on an extensive marine species database in the Indo-Malay-Philippines Archipelago (which is part of what is known as the Coral Triangle), confirmed that the highest concentration of marine species per unit area is found in the Philippines.
