For us, the BBNJ instrument must promote greater coherence with and shall complement existing relevant legal instruments and frameworks and relevant global, regional and sectoral bodies, in a manner that does not undermine the effectiveness of those instruments, frameworks and bodies. We look forward to discussing these and other points with fellow delegations in this session.
