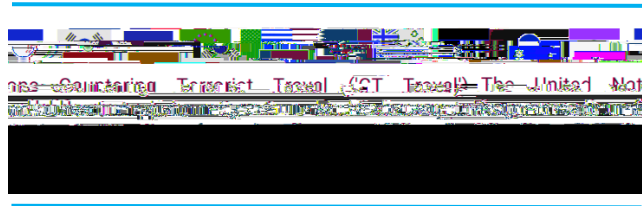


– The United Nations Office of Counter-Terrorism (UNOCT) and the Government of the United States of America represented by the Department of State (DOS) and the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) formalizing their strategic partnership to strengthen co-operation in

requirements of Security Council resolutions [2178](#) (2014), [2396](#) (2017), and [2482](#) (2019), ICAO standards and recommended practices, and other applicable international law obligations. More than 75 Member States have joined the CT Travel Programme since its launch in May 2019.
