

A LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROCLAMATION OF THE

EXCLUSIVE ECONOMIC ZONE BY THE REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS
(2nd April 2004)

The House of Representatives enacts as follows:

Short Title. 1. This Law may be cited as the Exclusive Economic Zone Law of 2004.

Interpretation. 2. (1) In this Law, unless the context otherwise requires-

"Exclusive Economic Zone" means the zone bounded and defined as follows-

Proclamation 3 (1) By this Law, the Exclusive Economic Zone is proclaimed, the outer limit [redacted] 200 nautical miles from the [redacted]

Rights and Duties of other States in the Exclusive Economic Zone.

5. (1) In exercising its rights and performing its duties under this Law in the Exclusive Economic Zone, the Republic shall have due regard to the rights and duties of other States and shall act in a manner compatible with the provisions of the Convention.

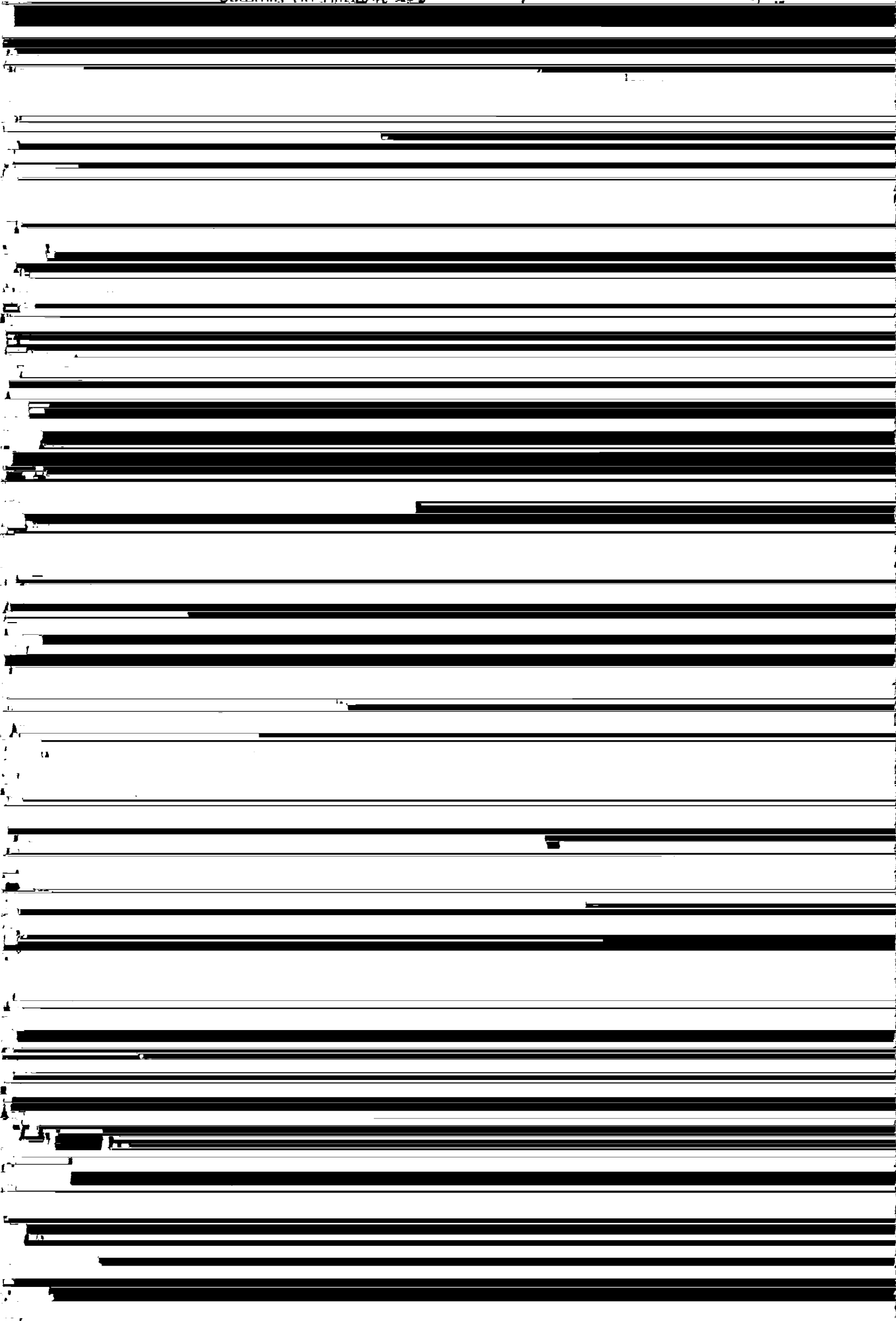
(2) In the Exclusive Economic Zone of the Republic, the other States enjoy the rights and perform the duties provided under the Convention. In exercising their rights and performing their duties, States shall have due regard to the rights and duties of the Republic and shall comply with the laws and regulations adopted by the Republic in accordance with the provisions of the Convention and

with the relevant Part of the Convention.
