The Secretary General of the United Nations has received from the Secretary-General of Chile a communication dated 20 September 1974, in which the Secretary-General of Chile requests that the United Nations Secretariat should, in accordance with article 84, paragraph 1, of the Convention on the High Seas, determine the baselines from which the breadth of the Chilean continental shelf should be measured. The communication also contains a list of points which the Secretary-General of Chile proposes as "Local Datum" points for the purpose of determining the baselines.

With regard to the points proposed, the following information is available: [.] *Chart No. 100* (containing) and the information on points defined therein are contained in the *International Hydrographic Chart No. 100* (containing) (Second Edition) published in 1973. The baselines of Chile are shown in the *International Hydrographic Chart No. 100*.

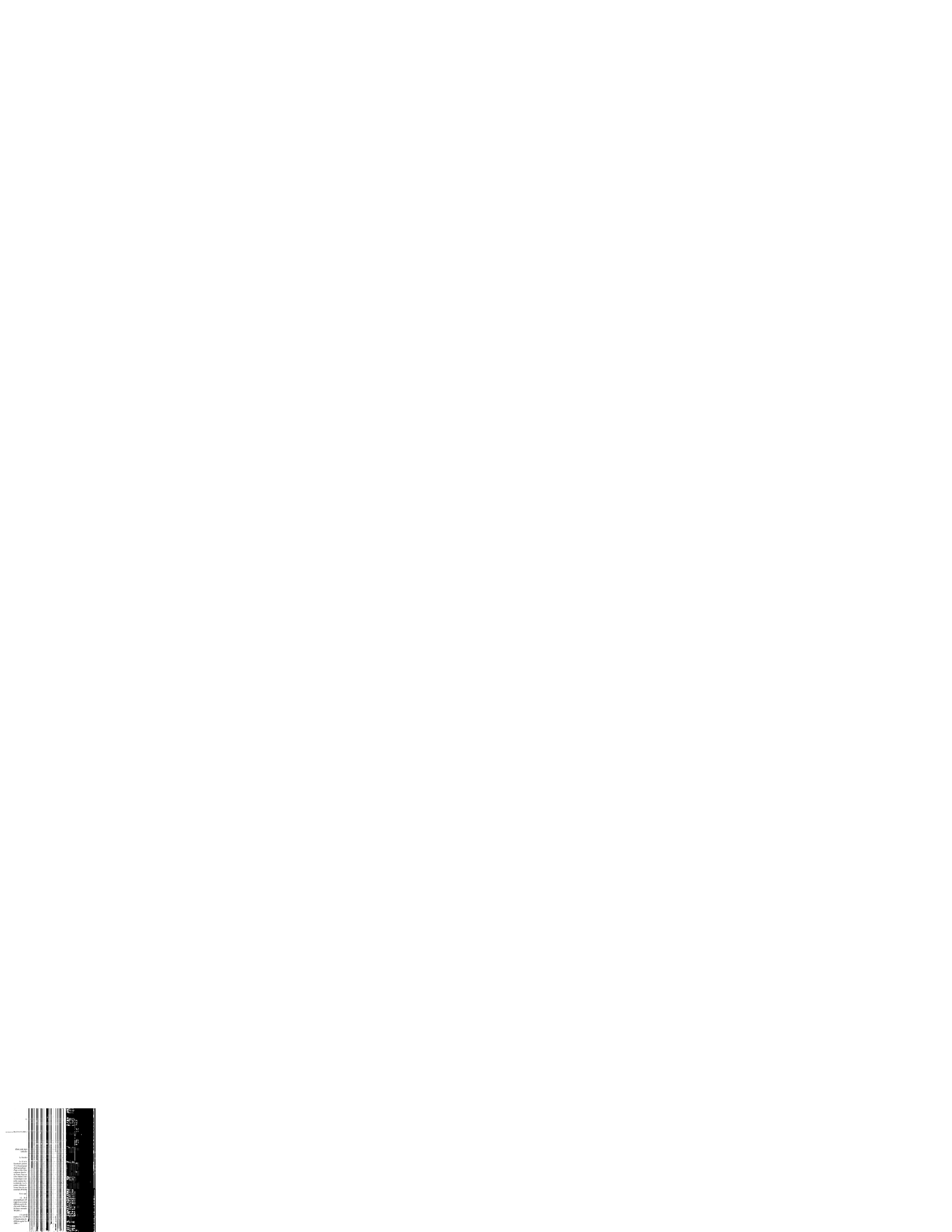
