to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf

The Secretary-General of the United Nations hereby notifies the following:

Continental Shelf in accordance with Article 76, paragraph 8 of the Convention

information on the limits of the continental shelf beyond 200 nautical miles from the

baseline from which its breadth is measured for three separate areas:

in the North-East Atlantic and the Arctic: the Lomonosov Ridge, the Gakkel Ridge, the Mendeleyev Ridge, the Western

Nansen Basin in the Arctic Ocean; and the Rana Hole in the Norwegian Sea

According to the submitting State: "[t]he present submission deals only with the

outer limits of the continental shelf in these three areas. A further submission may be

made in respect of other areas.

It is noted that the Convention entered into force for Norway on 24 July 1996

in accordance with Article 309 of the Convention, in order to make public the executive summary of the

submission, including all charts and coordinates contained in that summary. The

The consideration of the submission made by Norway shall be included in the

provisional agenda of the nineteenth session of the Commission  
from 5 March to 13 April 2007.

Upon completion of the consideration of the submission, the Commission shall make  
recommendations pursuant to Article 76 of the Convention.
