Health and safety considerations

On 17 May 2022, the COVID-19 alert level in New York City was raised to "High" by the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene. The World Health Organization's International Health Regulations (IHR) Emergency Committee on Occupational Safety and Health, in its advisory opinion on 17 May 2022, recommended that indoor public spaces at United Nations Headquarters, including hallways, cafeteria and meeting rooms, is strongly encouraged to protect personnel and delegates, it is recommended that participants consider wearing a mask while indoors in the Assembly Hall and in conference rooms.
