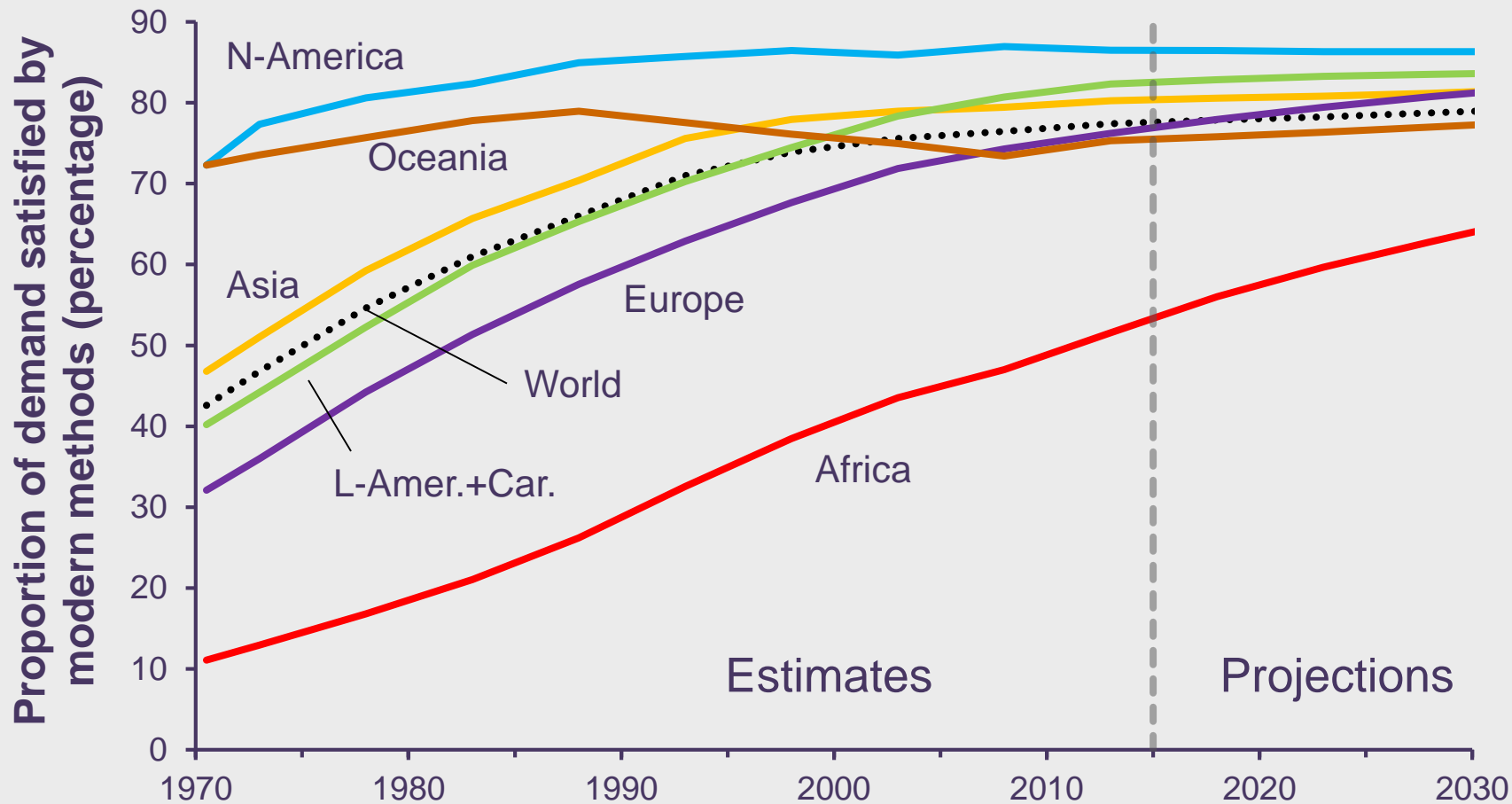


# Population by geographic regions

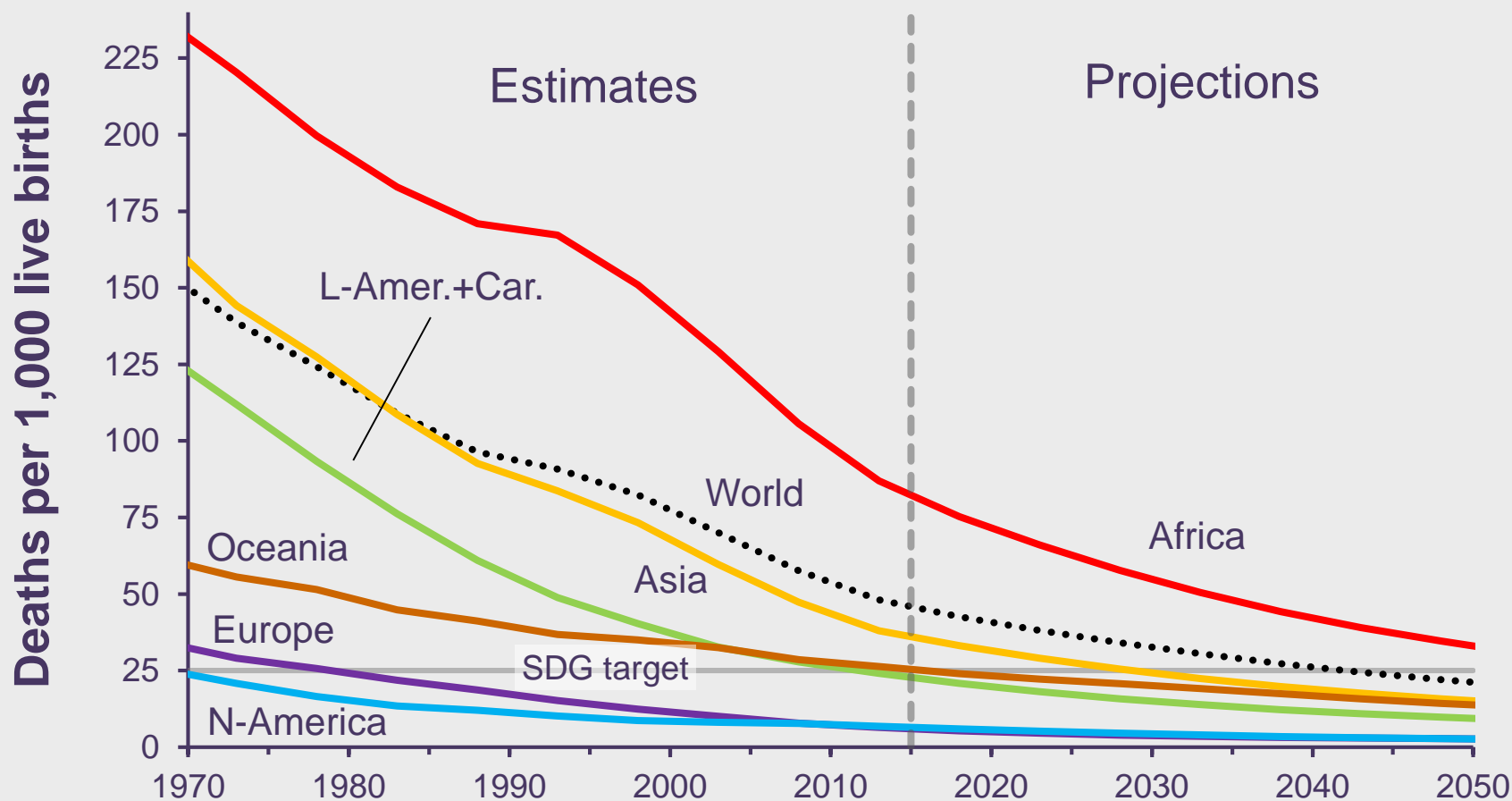

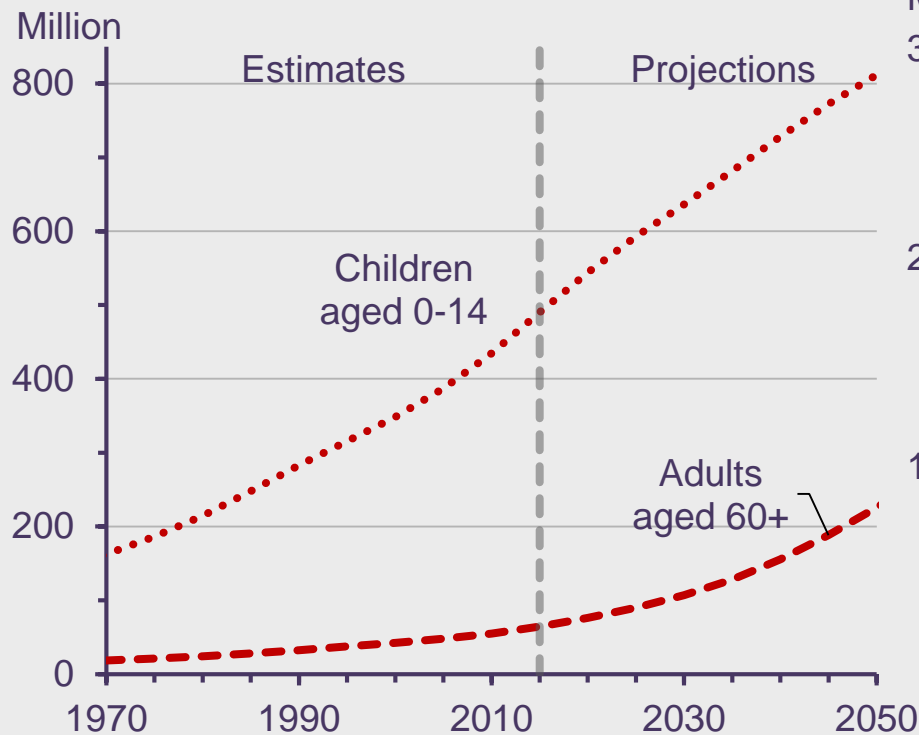

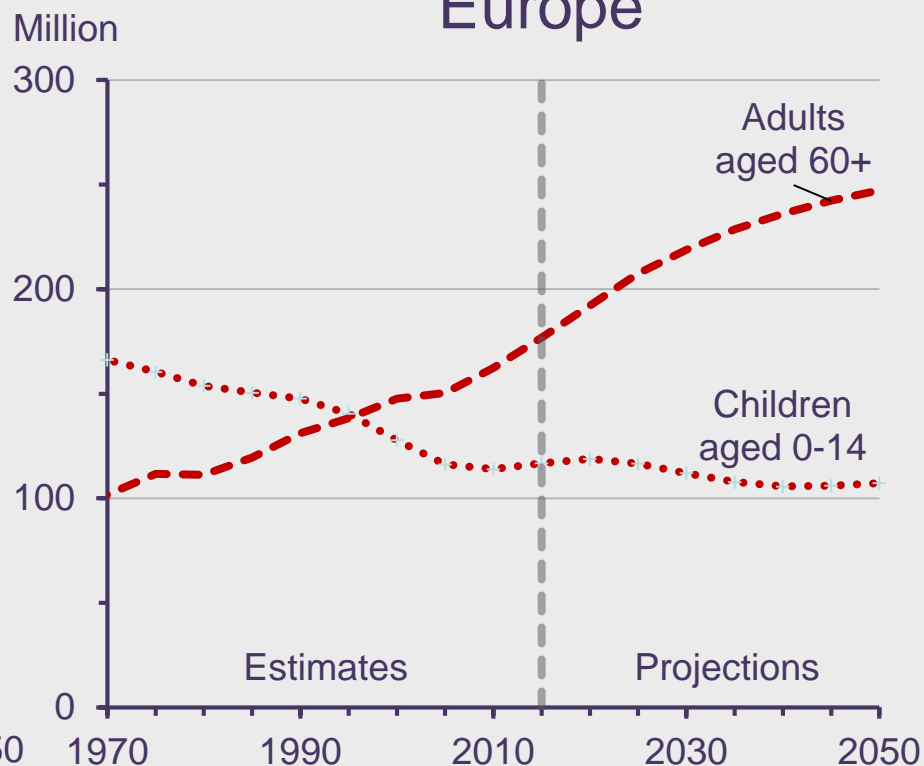

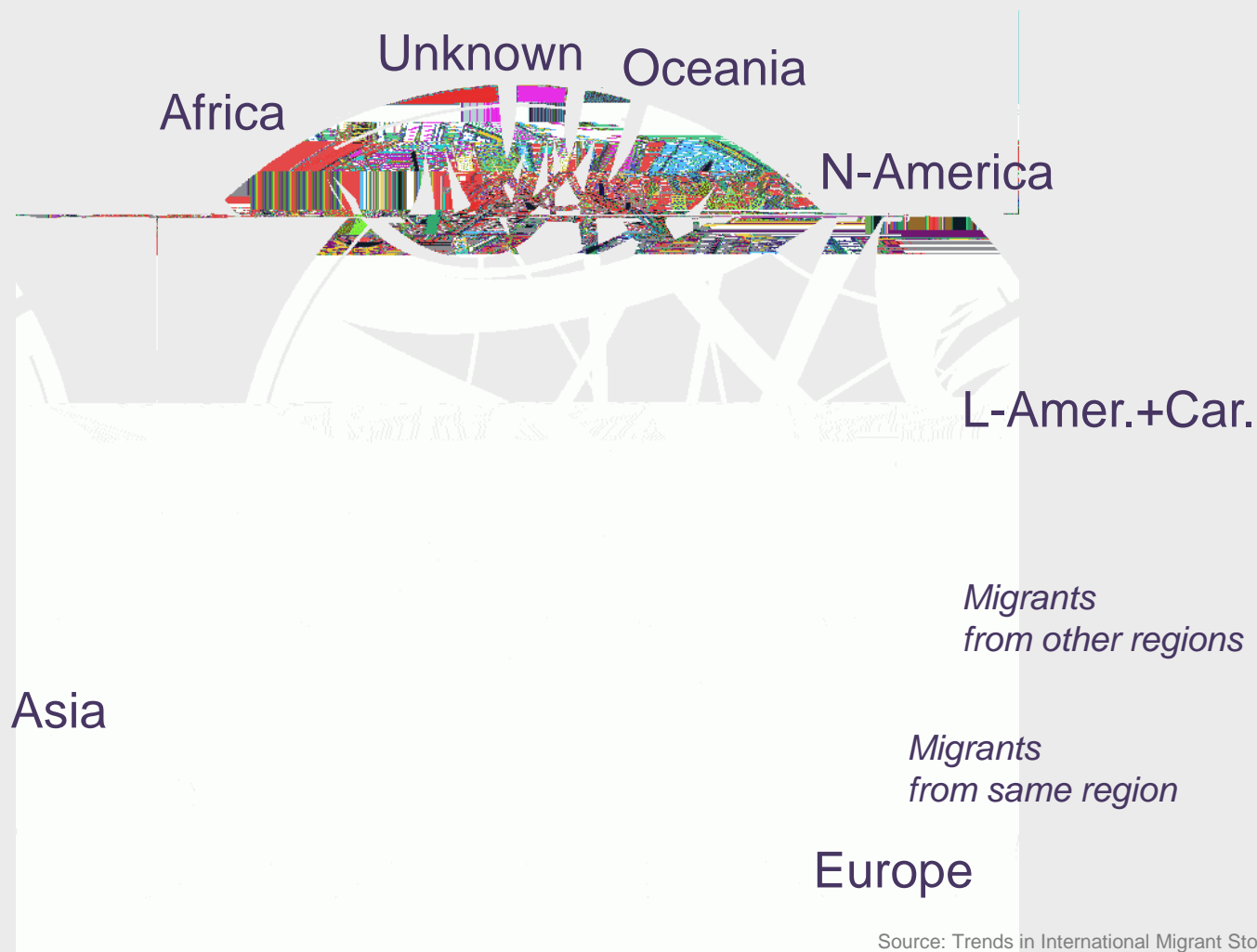
