

Background/Overview on Bangladesh


- Bangladesha SouthAsiancountry, got independence 1971 and located between 20°34' to 26°38' north latitude and 88°01' to 92°41' eastlongitude
- Total population is 1665 million with a RNI of 1.32 and sex ratio of 100.2(2019).
- 9.16% of the total population are agedbetween 10-14 years (9.26% boysand 9.06% girls) (UNPOPDivision, 2020).
- 9.46% of the total population are agedbetween 15-19 years (9.58% boysand 9.35% girls) (UNPOPDivision, 2020).
- Bangladeshanks135th in HumanDevelopmentIndexin 2019 (0.614)
- Total fertility rate of the country is 2.3 per woman and it is stagnantfor about 10 years

Age Specific (10-14 years) Fertility Rate/1000, Top Ten Countries


Age Specific (15-19 years) Fertility Rate/1000, Top Ten Countries




Women (20-24 years) first married by exact age 18: Top Ten Countries




Trends of TFR and ASFR in Bangladesh, 1993-2017




Trends of Child Marriage in Bangladesh, 1993-2017
