

15th Coordination Meeting on International Migration

- 2% The inclusion, communication and mobilization of all stakeholders, including constituencies at the local, national, regional and global levels is essential. The engagement and incorporation of the views of migrants themselves is particularly important.
- 3% The compact should strive to focus on practical solutions, learning from prior experience of intergovernmental agreements, including the success factors of the 4CPD Programme of Action and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.
- 5% The #or\$ an international deliberations must be based on accurate data and evidence to inform the development of the global compact and to carry forward the global campaign to combat xenophobia, intolerance and discrimination.
- 6% All the organizations represented in this meeting have a collective responsibility to live up to the call by the Secretary-General and of Member States to #or\$ together to #ar \$ a successful compact on migration.
