Mauritius argued before the ICJ that the separation of the Chagos from Mauritius was in breach of 1514 paragraph six which specifically prohibits the breakup of colonies before independence. The judgment in favour of

this argument was 13 to 1. Mauritius Prime Minister said its territorial integrity would now be made
