These policies strengthen the corrupt officials and criminal gangs who profit from vulnerable people. These policies criminalize and throw vulnerable people into the hands of those who ruthlessly exploit them**

**Whether these policies are simply ill-informed, or are the manifestation of deliberate collusion with corruption and criminality, the result is the same: they fail to stop migration - and they kill people**
