Figure 1. Schematic diagram of the experimental setup. The laser beam (blue arrow) is focused onto the sample surface (red arrow) through a lens system consisting of lenses L₁, L₂, and L₃. The sample is placed on a rotating stage (black arrow). The scattered light is collected by a lens system consisting of lenses L₄, L₅, and L₆ and detected by a photomultiplier tube (PMT) (green arrow). The angle between the incident laser beam and the detection axis is denoted by θ.

The sample is mounted on a stage (black arrow) which is connected to a piezoelectric transducer (PT). The laser beam is generated by a pulsed Nd:YAG laser (not shown).
