The Humanitarian dimension of migration must be addressed, and the World Bank's role in providing support to countries affected by migration must be acknowledged.


Finally, we must recognize that migration is a reality that cannot be ignored, and that it must be managed in a way that respects the rights of migrants and promotes their well-being.
