

Figure 1. A schematic diagram of the experimental setup. The light source (laser) emits light at $\lambda = 532$ nm. The beam splitter (BS) splits the beam into two paths. The first path contains a lens (L₁) and a polarizer (P₁). The second path contains a lens (L₂) and a polarizer (P₂). The two paths converge at a point where they are imaged by a camera (C). The distance between the lenses L₁ and L₂ is $d = 10$ cm.

Figure 1. A schematic diagram of the experimental setup. The light source (laser) emits light through a lens and beam splitter. The beam splitter splits the light into two paths: one path goes through a polarizer and lens to a photomultiplier tube (PMT), and the other path goes through a lens and beam splitter to a second PMT.
