At its 1st plenary meeting, on 18 September 2018, the General Assembly, in accordance with rule 28 of its rules of procedure, appointed a Credentials Committee for its seventy-third session consisting of the following Member States: ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA, CHILE, CHINA, FINLAND, GHANA, PALAU, RUSSIAN FEDERATION, SIERRA LEONE and UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

At its 19th plenary meeting, on 12 October 2018, the General Assembly, pursuant to its resolutions 60/251 of 15 March 2006 and 65/281 of 17 June 2011, elected ARGENTINA, AUSTRIA, the BAHAMAS, BAHRAIN, BANGLADESH, BULGARIA, BURKINA FASO, CAMEROON, CZECHIA, DENMARK, ERITREA, FIJI, INDIA, ITALY, the PHILIPPINES, SOMALIA, TOGO and URUGUAY as members of the Human Rights Council for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2019 to fill the vacancies occurring on the expiration of the terms of office of BELGIUM, BURUNDI, CÔTE D'IVOIRE, ECUADOR, ETHIOPIA, GEORGIA, GERMANY, KENYA, KYRGYZSTAN, MONGOLIA, PANAMA, the PHILIPPINES, the REPUBLIC OF KOREA, SLOVENIA, SWITZERLAND, TOGO, the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and URUGUAY.
