In this regard, while thankful for the efforts of the President of the General Assembly, we are obliged to note that the draft Oral Decision in question does not address some legitimate concerns expressed by our group in relation to the intergovernmental negotiations on Security Council reform (IGN). The draft, as it stands, does not adequately reflect the progress achieved during the five rounds of the IGN held this year under the leadership of the Co-Chairs, H.E. Ms. Joanna Wronecka, Permanent Representative of Poland to the United Nations, and H. E. Ms. Alya Ahmed Saif Al-Thani, Permanent Representative of the State of Qatar.
