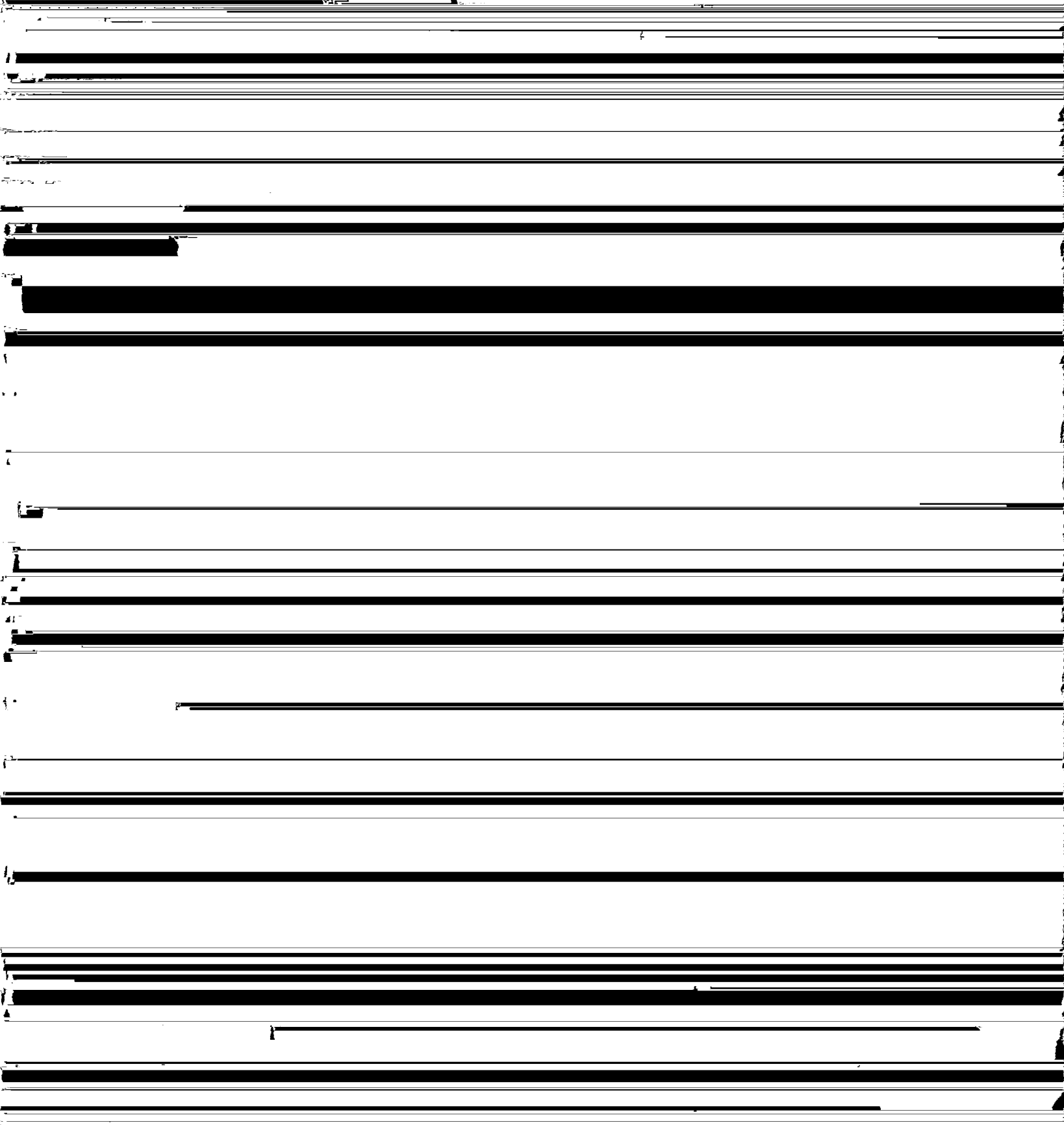

On this regard it is noted that to date, there has been no statutory criminalization of the act of piracy under Malaysian laws.
