In response to the string **dtacks** described above, the Minnjsof Foreign Affairs of Chile put in place a document inspection procedure th**tatilen**he use of a ferrous metal detector. In order to implement this measure, the Minnjsot cquired 200 Garrenthetal detectors and a meticulous document inspection protocol, translanted Spanish, English, French and German, and supplied them to

- 50 consulates-general
- 10 career consulates
- 5 consular sections
- 4 consulates
- 5 missions to international organizations
- 50 honorary consulates.

It should be noted that the preventive measure has led to the ection of letter bombs sent to the Embassies in Mexico, Spain and Greecengenothers, and to their subsequent deactivation by local police forces.

It should also be noted thiat 2010, the Ministry of ForeigAffairs, having foreseen this risk, introduced security systems with the featurescribed below as the technical standard for preventive security at all Chilean diplomations ular and other missions abroad. These systems have the capacity to monitor premises other the General Packet Radio Service (GPRS) communication system, which transmits an activation and directly to the ellular telephone of the mission's chief security officer, who can the mestigate the cause the activation.

- Closed-circuit television equipped with agidal video recorder, infrared cameras and display screens. The system can store im fage 30 days and has 30 minutes of reserve power

- Electronic access control and security doons feature prevents unauthorized access to the offices. The system is connected to be a system so that the doors can open while the alarm is activated. It also has reserve power that allows it to run without a direct electrical supply for 24 hours

- A fire alarm system, supplemented by fire extinguishers.
