Contains information (summaries of work, links to documents, programme of work, details of the Bureau and Secretariat) relating to the work of the Sixth Committee during the current session of the General Assembly, as well as links to previous sessions (1997 onwards). Provides links to the official documents (available for viewing or downloading in all official languages), to be considered by the Sixth Committee; presented by meeting of the Committee as well as by agenda item. e-Room (accessible from the Sixth Committee website) – restricted

An in-session tool for delegations providing a restricted common space for the sharing of information and documents, such as informal documentation (e.g. working papers, non-papers), and information on focal points and coordinators for each agenda item. Access to the e-Room is restricted to delegations of member States. Requests for password access should be addressed to 6thcommittee@un.org.
