The Working Group had before it thwritten comments of Governments issued in the most recent report of the

- Second, despite such support, there remain sôtrates who oppose the conclusion of a convention, including for reasons regarding concerns relating to specific provisions of thereticles on diplomatic protection; and
- Third, there exist a further group States who would perfer to defer a decision on how to proceed, one waythose other, until the final decision on the fate of the articles on the respiblinisity of States for internationally wrongful acts is taken.

With these conclusionism mind, there was agreemnt in the Working Group that the most feasible way forwared, the present session was to work on the basis of a draft resolution deferring decision on the fate on he articles on diplomatic protection to a future session.

The discussions on a text for suchdraft resolution were subsequently undertaken on the basis of bilateral **caunts**, which I had with delegations, and which I will refer to upon in
