Mr. Chairman,

Egypt wishes to reaffirm the portance of the universal observance of the instruments of international humanitarian law, including the 1977 Additional Protocols. We express satisfaction with the number of countries that had tified the 1977 Additional Protocols and urge the States that had not yet done so, to ratify them as soon as possible.

We commend the role of the International Committee of the Red Cross in the promotion and the dissemination of International Humanitarian Law in general and in particular, its work for a betterunderstanding of and compliance to international humanitarian law and we encourage it to continue its efforts in this respect.
