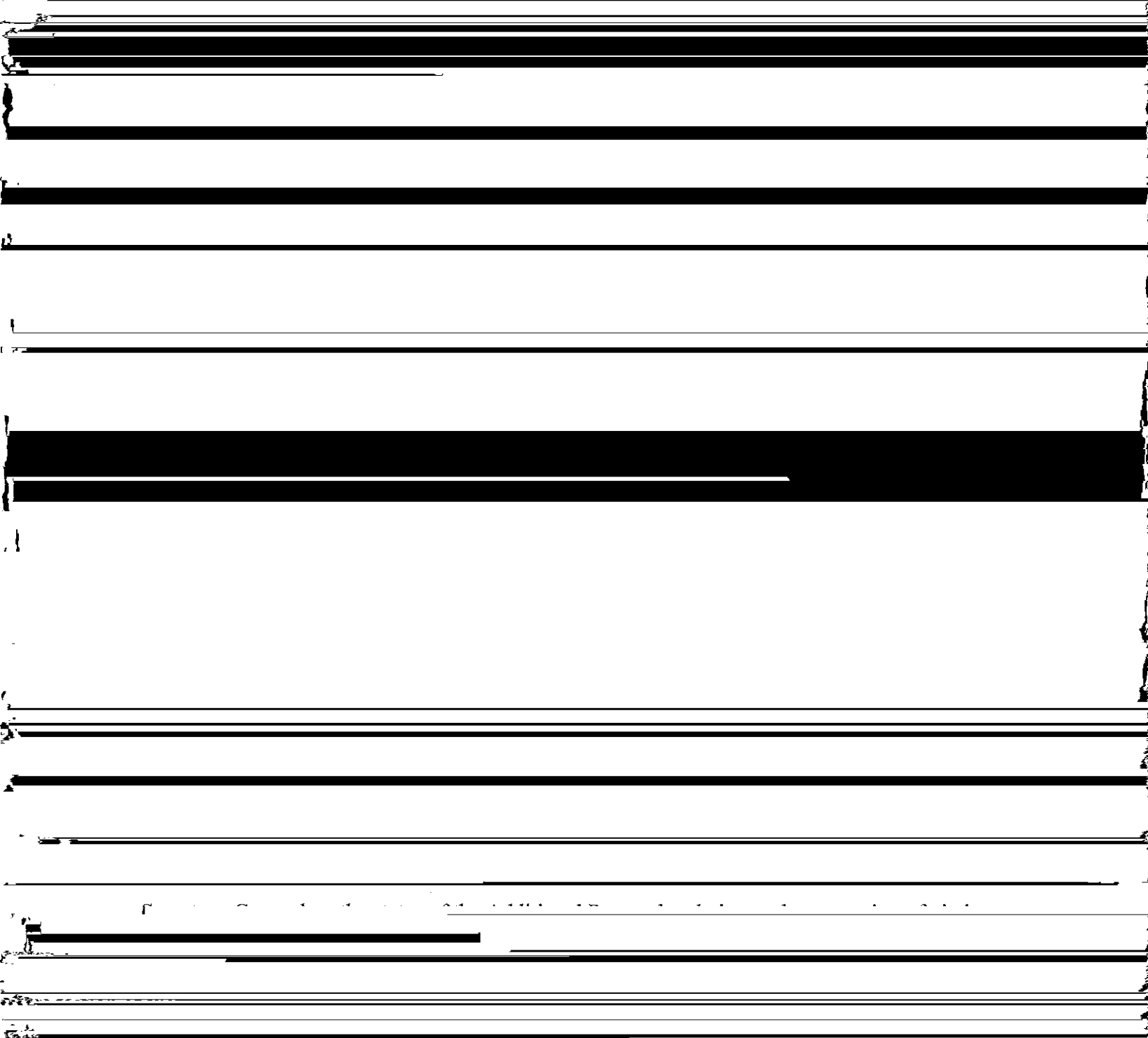

The Republic of El Salvador submits this report pursuant to General Assembly resolution

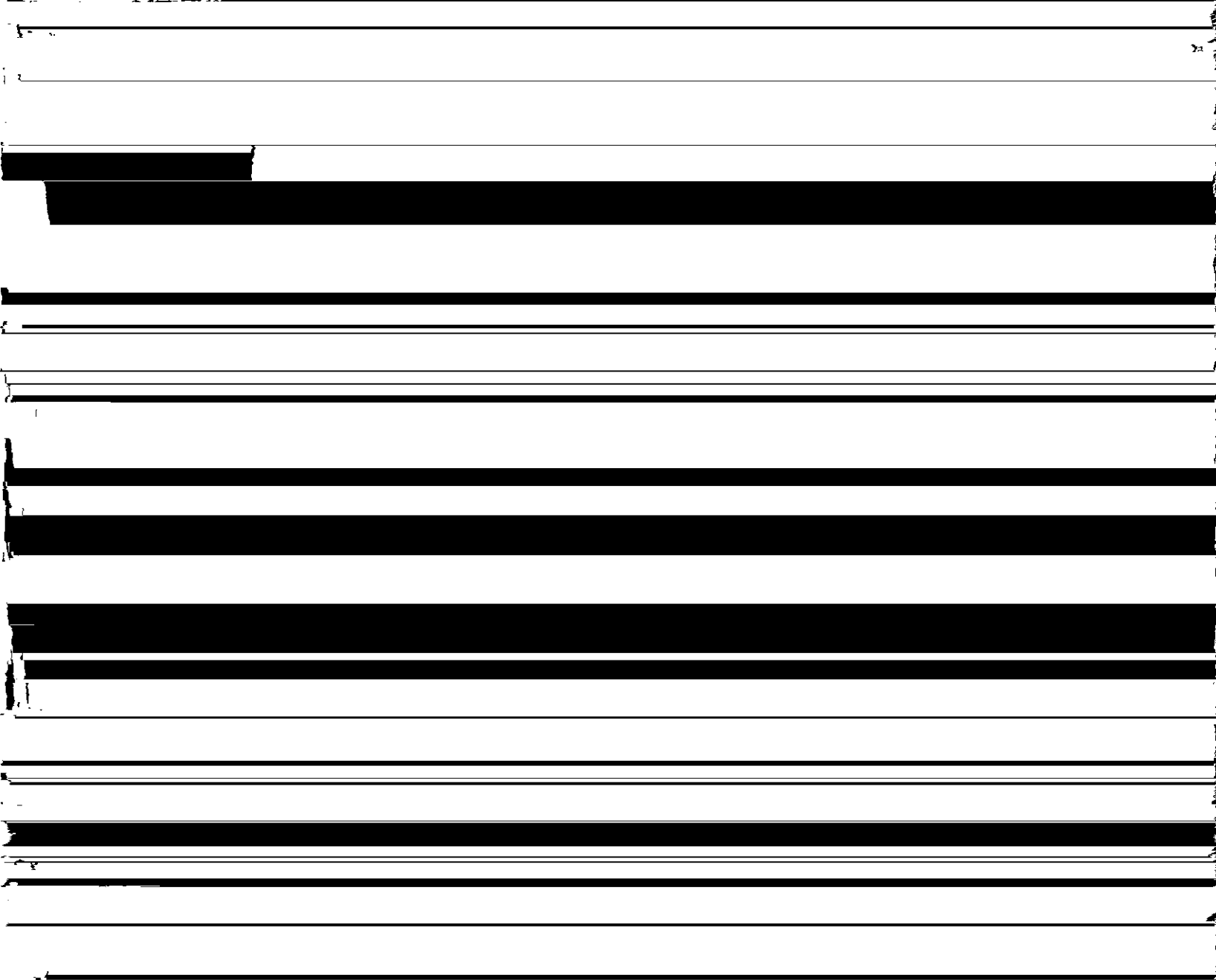
67/93, paragraph 1, which Member States are invited to submit reports to the Secretary-General
