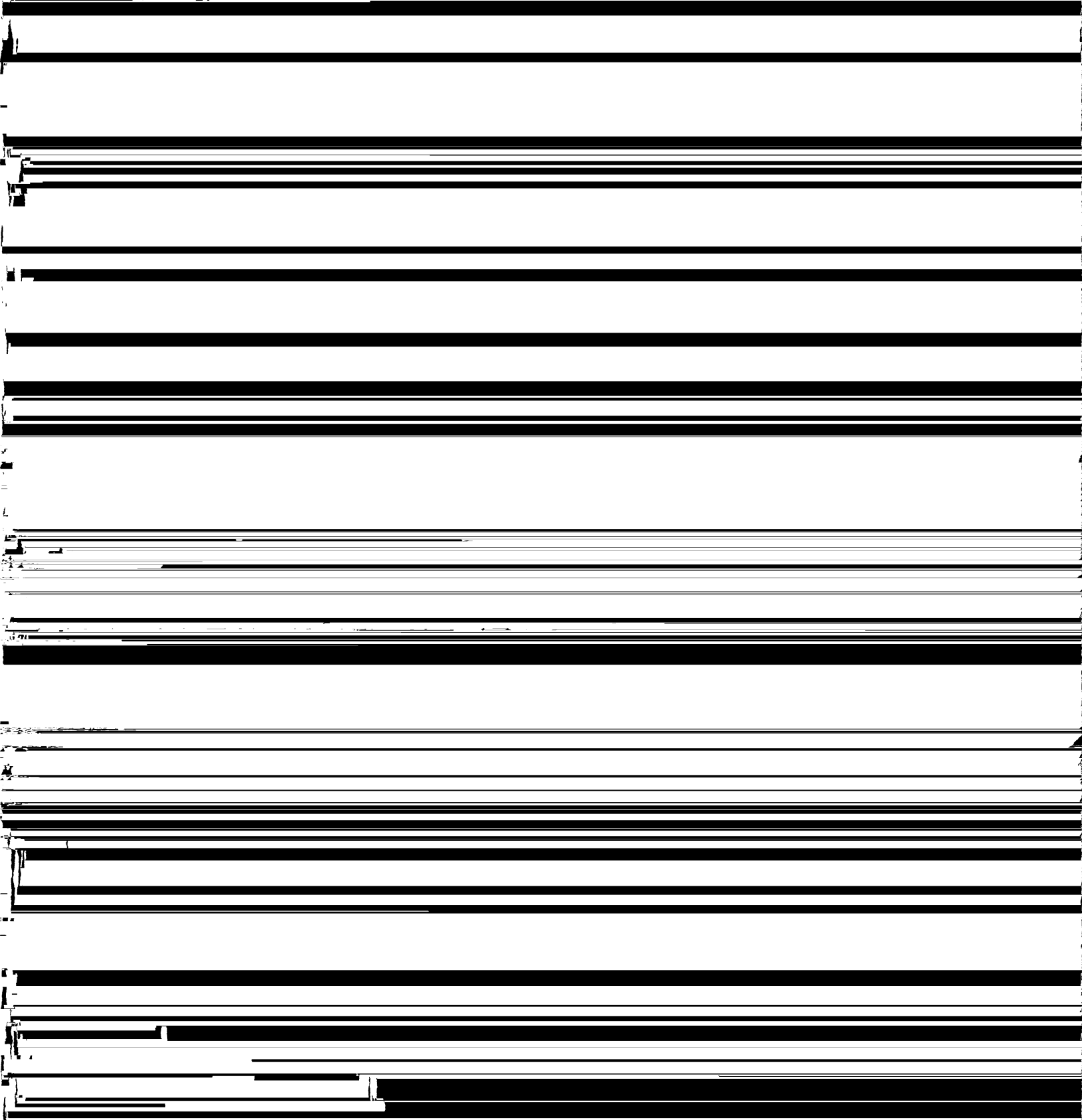
2. I would like to thank the Secretary General for his report submitted under
