- 5. Although the International Law Fellowship Programme scheduled to hold from 29th June to 10th August 2020 could not hold as planned, my delegation commends the effort made by the Division to provide the applicants with a remote self paced learning curriculum designed by the division as an interim means of capacity building.
- 6. Nigeria recognises that the UN Audiovisual Library of international law is another essential tool that aids in facilitating a wider understanding of international law. We, therefore, urge the UN to continue to promote access and
