Not only now, the military committed crimes against humanity in the past including against Rohingya people in 2017. Therefore National Unity Government is accely seeking accountability and justice for past and oingcrimes committed by the military. The NUG is committed to ensuring accountability and ending impunity for those high ranking officials and their subordinates from the military who committed regripolation of human rights and international humanitarian law.
