Regarding Cluster V, my delegation has the following brief remark to make as to Article 5 of the draft articles concerning *non-refoulement*.

We agree that on state may expel, return, surrender or extradite a person to another state where there are substantial grounds for believing that he or she would be in danger of being subjected to a crime against humanityö as per Article 5/1 of the draft articles under discussion.
