The EU and its Member Statesgaged constructively the debate of the Special Committee on the Charter earlier this yeal/Ne welcome the opportunity to provide meremans on its work.

First, we welcomed the annual briefingndUN sanctions. The EU firmly believes that UN sanctions must be implemented in full compliance with international law, in particular international humanitarial was and an another and an another region of listed persons, including process rights. The EU fally committed to preserving the humanitarian space. In this regard, we welcome the adoption of UN Security Council Resolution 266 introducing a humanitarian carve ut to asset freeze measures across UN sanctions regimes. We welcome the reference the Haiti Resolution 2653 to the

Al Qaida sanctions regimes.

Secondly, we werepleased to participate in the thematic debate on the resort to regional agencies or arrangements as a peaceful means of dispute settle. When thook forward to discussing other means of peaceful settlement of disputets next session of the Special Committee indicated on previous occasions we see merit in discussing topics that are-political and that do not duplicate discussions sewhere in the United Nations.

Serbia and Bosnia and Herzegovina continue to be part of the Stabilisation and Association Process.

Lastly, we recall that last March the Special Committee on the Charter concluded its work without the adoption of substantive report would like to mark our disappointment the fact that for the second consecutive year substantive eport could not be adopted due to position by one delegation to put on record what has been discussed in the room.
