1 Singapore participated actively in the important debate generated by the & R P P L V V L R Q ¶ V Z R U N R Q W K L V W R S W E W e l c o m e this opportunity to do so again. This time, Singapore has benefited from the two additional reports by the Secretary General in documents A/78/83 and A/78/135. That said, our position has not changed. Singapore does not support the elaboration of a convention on the basis of the draft articles on the topic.

2 First, Singapore is still not convinced that the draft articles, taken as a whole, embody consensus views on the law relating to the responsibility of international organizations. We have reviewed the two additional reports prepared by the Secretary General which were issued in 2023. These reports do not suggest that there has been any material change in the overall considered this topic in 2020, or
