Mr. President,

Costa Rica commends you and the other members of the Bureau for your election, and we wish you success in the development of the work of this commission.

We express our solidarity with the people of Türkiye, for the recent events that prove that peace and security are invaluable assets that we must safeguard and promote at all times. We are facing a complex conjuncture with intertwined challenges that require a global response.

One such global response may be to begin by agreeing - once and for all - on a universal legal definition of terrorism.

That call is not a new one.

At the previous session, two groups and various countries, for a total of 94 States, as well as civil society, we reiterated the urgent need to have such a definition.

In this regard, Costa Rica wishes to raise four points:

First, as we stated at the plenary meeting of the General Assembly for the adoption of the eighth review of the United Nations Global Counter-Terrorism Strategy this past June 22, my delegation reiterates its deepest disappointment at not having taken advantage of the opportunity to fully integrate human rights and a gender perspective as cross-cutting priorities in its four pillars.
