The most prominent measures taken by Jordan to eliminate international terrorism are as follows:

1. Jordan has built capacities for training in tactical operations, detection of cybercrime, handling of explosives, investigation of violent crime, forensics, training of trainers, programmes and combating money laundering and human trafficking.

2. The institutional structure is as follows:

- ) counter-cybercrime unit to tackle all forms of cybercrime
- ) community policing branch in the Public Security Directorate
- ) social harmony centre within the Preventive Security Department, Public Security Directorate
- ) gender capacity building centre and a gender branch within the Preventive Security Department
- ) department for laboratory testing and hazardous substances in the Forensic Science Directorate and a counter-explosives unit in the Preventive Security Directorate
