- 1. Pursuant to General Assembly resolution 78/102 of 7 December 2023, the Sixth Committee decided, at its 1st meeting, on 2 October 2024, to establish a working group, with the view to continuing the consideration of the report of the Group of Legal Experts (A/60/980), in particular its legal aspects, taking into account the views of Member States and also noting the inputs by the Secretariat. The Committee also decided to open the Working Group to all States Members of the United Nations or members of the specialized agencies or of the International Atomic Energy Agency.
- 2. At its 1st meeting, on 2 October 2024, the Sixth Committee also elected Mr. Marvin as Chairperson of the Working Group.
- 3. The Working Group had before it the report of the Group of Legal Experts on ensuring the accountability of United Nations staff and experts on mission with respect to criminal acts committed in peacekeeping operations (A/60/980); the two reports of the Secretary-General

ensure that that there is no impunity for criminal activity committed by United Nations officials and experts on mission. This concludes my oral report on the work of the Working Group on Criminal Accountability of United Nations Officials and Experts on Mission at this year's session.
