

Statement
by the Delegation of Ukraine at the UN GA Sixth Committee meeting under
agenda item 110 Measures to eliminate international terrorism
(2 October 2024, New York)

Mr. Chairman,

Let me join the previous speakers in congratulating you on the assumption of this position and wish every success in your work.

Terrorism poses one of the gravest threats to global peace, security, and stability, affecting every region of the world. It respects no borders, spares no nation, and undermines our shared commitment to uphold human dignity, sovereignty, territorial integrity and the rule of law.

We are affected by more sophisticated methods and tactics by terrorists, their mentors and sponsors are becoming crueler and more ambitious. Furthermore, some countries have integrated terrorism into their state policy that consequently has already led to flagrant violations of international law.

Ukraine remains committed to the Global Counter-Terrorism Strategy (GCTS) which, inter alia, reconfirms respect for sovereignty and territorial integrity of States,

and critical infrastructure are acts of state terrorism, and they must be met with decisive action by the international community.

On 31 January 2024 the International Court of Justice delivered its judgment on the [y](#) [k](#) [7](#) [@](#) Convention for the Suppression of the Financing of Terrorism and the International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination. The Court concluded that Russia violated both treaties. This is the first time in the history that the ICJ has
