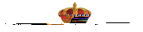

Mr. Chair,

At the outset, my delegation aligns itself with the statements made by the Non-Aligned Movement, the GOF of the Rule of Law and the Arab group and I would like to make the following remarks in our national capacity.

Jordan reaffirms that the rule of law is a fundamental pillar of the international system, emphasizing its critical intersection with a range of key issues such as peace and security, technology, human rights, socio-economic development, and access to justice, across situations including conflict and post-conflict settings.

Jordan recognizes the role that the rule of law plays in building and maintaining international peace and security and accelerates action on the Sustainable Development Goals, in particular Goal 16 on peace, justice and strong institutions.

Jordan believes that the international community needs to cooperate in resolving the challenges linked to climate change, the rights of future generations, accountability for serious international crimes, corruption

and insufficiently governed digital spaces, and the use of digital technology, as the report of the Secretary General highlights



- x In this context, we call on the international community to ensure accountability for the unlawful use of force as well as the commission of grave international crimes, including genocide, ethnic cleansing, war crimes, and crimes against humanity against Palestinian people in Gaza, West Bank and people of Lebanon.
- x Jordan reiterates its condemnation of the ongoing violations by Israel, the occupying power, of the rule of law and their breach of international law, particularly international humanitarian law, international human rights law, and the UN Charter.
- x In the context of participation in the international legal system, Jordan reemphasizes the vital role women must play in decision making across all levels. Ensuring inclusivity is crucial for providing equal opportunities for all to influence decision making and the creation and implementation of the rules of international law.
- x Jordan is of the view that sources of international law should

should contribute to the development of the rule of international law.

x In closing, Jordan wishes to reiterate its commitment to the advancement of the rule of law at all levels. We look forward to proactive and fruitful discussions
