7. By letter dated 12 January 2006, the ICJ brought the UNJSPF's request to the attention of the ICJ and invited the UNJSPF to provide the ICJ with the information requested. The ICJ Panel determined that the UNJSPF had not provided the information requested by the ICJ Panel.

8. In a letter dated 21 September 2006 to the UNJSPF, the ICJ Panel invited the UNJSPF to provide the information requested by the ICJ Panel by 12 January 2006.
