Introduction and Procedural History

1. The Applicant maintains that he joined the United Nations Mission in South Sudan (“UNMISS”) in May 2009 and served as an individual contractor until October 2009. From October 2009 to October 2012, he served as a national staff with UNMISS. Thereafter, his employment was extended until 2017 as an individual contractor.

2. On 10 January 2023, the Applicant filed an application in which he contested various decisions which he claimed had been made during the period of his employment with UNMISS.

Consideration

3. The Tribunal notes that art. 8.4 of the UNDT Statute states that “an application shall not be receivable if it is filed more than three years after the applicant’s receipt of the contested administrative decision.”

4. The application in this matter was filed more than three years after the receipt of the contested decisions.

5. Therefore, the application is not receivable *ratione temporis*.

Conclusion

6. The application is rejected as not receivable.
