#### Introduction

1. On 10 March 2021, the Applicant, a former staff member with the United Nations Secretariat, filed, by email to the New York Registry, an application requesting urgent relief under art. 2.2 of the Dispute Tribunal's Statute and art. 13 of its Rules of Procedure.

### Consideration

- 2. Under art. 2.2 of the Dispute Tribunal's Statute and art. 13.1 of the Rules of Procedure, the Tribunal may suspend the implementation of a contested administrative decision during the pendency of management evaluation. For an application for suspension of action to be receivable, a response to a request for management evaluation must therefore be pending.
