- SCPhot well integrated into work of economics and line ministries
- Scarceesourcesnot fully alignedwith priorities
- Existingexpertise,knowledgeandresourcesnot tapped fully
- Lesthan full participation of stakeholders in processes

- Relatedinitiatives not linked
- Potentialof relevantUNAgenciesnot realised
- Limitedability to respondto emergingissues and changing ircumstances
- No processfor reviewingprogress

- •BuildGlobalSCPAlliances/Partnerships take leadin areaswhere internationalinstitutions have no comparative advantage
- Linkchampionsandpartnershipsto regionalnetworksthroughpooled technicalservices training and capacity building
- Undertakecoordinated researchinto aspectsof SCRstill not well understood, linked to regional priorities coordinated by a panel of governmentand other experts
- Mobilizeresourcesfor priority SCRnitiativesthroughmulti ragencymulti r donor trust fund
- Periodicallyreview progresson 10YFR hrough intergovernmental process

### Addressing the Challenges:

Basecon the most effective and successful eatures of the reviewed models, the following elements are suggested:

- Focus or SCP and mainstreaming at national level formal designation of focal points (SAICM)
- Highleveland formal involvement of a broad range of stakeholders in setting priorities and responding to emerging issues for example through a global forum (SAICMMDG)
- Coordinationand coherence through a dedicated secretariat, possibly with a leadagency (SAICM Marrakech Process)
