The Group of LDCs seeks support from its development partners in enhance efficiency in tax collection and broadening the tax base. It requires strengthened inveSMEs which can create employment and inclusive growth. Improvising the banking stacilitate generating and getting access to more resources for long term

- (a) Eliminate safe havens that create incentives for transfer abroad of stolen assets at financial flows;
- (b) Assist in the recovery and return of stolen assets to the countries of origin, consist the United Nans Convention against Corruption;
- (c) Enhance disclosure practices and transparency in both source and destination and cooperate in efforts to reduce illicit financial flows.

Paragraph 32f the Zero Draft talks about ensuring access tourn rpinitrage of essential services by 2030. The Group would like to suggest the elaboration of the services, which include, among others, health, education, water and sanitation, en shelter.
