The main objective of the workshop was to clarify the reporting process to the United Nations Forum on Forests (UNFF) at its 15th session in 2020 and in particular to develop Explanatory Notes aimed at helping countries to prepare their national reports for submission to UNFF. In addition, the workshop aimed to advance work on methodologies for monitoring progress on Global Forest Goal 2 (GFG 2) and reporting on socio-economic issues related to forests and forestry and work on Indicators 13 and 14 of the Global Core Set of Forest-related indicators (GCS).
