We have forest policies and strategies at regional and continental levels (e.g African Union Sustainable Forest Management Framework, COMIFAC and ECOWAS Forest Convergence Plans) which are being gradually domesticated and mainstreamed into the national structures and frameworks

Together with the FAO, we have embarked on mainstreaming biodiversity conservation into the whole spectrum of agriculture including forestry, wildlife, livestock and fisheries.

We are planning with FAO in early 2020 a regional training workshop on the promotion of NTPs as instruments of poverty alleviation and rural development.
