-- Meetingwith the AdvisoryCommittee on Administrative and BudgtaryQuestions (ACABQ)to discuss the comments and recommendations of the IAAC on the budgt for the Office of Internal Oversigt Services (OIOS) under the support account for peacekeeping perations for the period 1 uly 2010 to 0 une 2011. -- Meetingwith the Under-Secretary eneral for Internal Oversigt Services and senior manages and staff of OIOS. The IAAC continued their discussions with OIOS on the risk-based work planning process. In addition, they discussed standard agnda items with OIOS such as hig risks identified by OIOS, implementation of oversigt recommendations, and OIOS staff vacancies. OIOS briefed the IAAC on highigts of the annual report on peacekeeping peratons and the challengs faced by OIOS Auditors based in the field.

-- The Department of Managment briefed the IAAC on the proposals in the Report of the Secretary@neral Towards an Account abilitySystem in the United Nations Secretariat."The IAAC has a responsibility to advise the @neral Assemblyon qalityand overall effectiveness of risk managment procedures and deficiencies in the internal control framework of the United Nations. In this respect, the IAAC will review the report of the Secretary@neralwith a view to providingcomments to the @neral Assemblywhere applicable. The IAAC plans to issue a related report on its views.

In this session, the IAAC also discussed the IAAC's approach to the review of its terms of reference which the General Assemblydecided to conduct in the sity fifth session. The IAAC's related recommendations will be included in its 2010 annual report.
