

- 20. On 24 March 2014, i.e., the first day of the Appeals Tribunal's spring session, Ms. Ourmin filed a Motion for Withdrawal of her appeal in the instant case. In explanation, she stated, simply: "Applicant wishes to with draw her appeal on the grounds that she no longer wishes to pursue this appeal."
- 21. In view of the fact that a panel of Judges had been constituted and assigned to the case, that all relevant documentation had been reviewed and prepared, and deliberations had taken place, as scheduled, the day the Appeals Tribunal received the Motion to Withdraw, we decided to dispose of the caseby Judgment, rather than Order.
- 22. As this Tribunal has consistently held, an Appellant may withdraw his or her appeal simply by giving notice; the request need not be justified.1 Accordingly, the Appeals Tribunal takes note of Ms. Oummih's succinct plea, and grants her Motion.

Judgment

23. The appeal having been withdrawn, Judgment No. UNDT/2013/043 remains in force.
