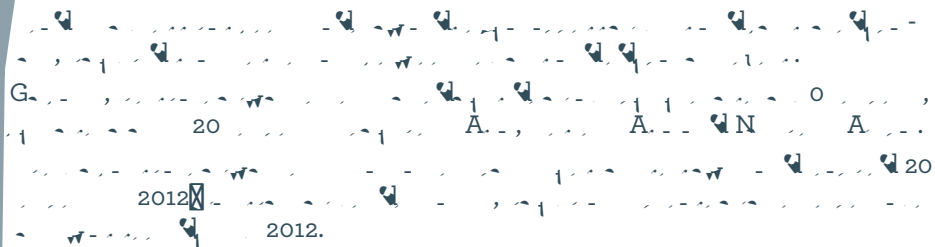


**GOAL 3 Promote gender equality and empower women**

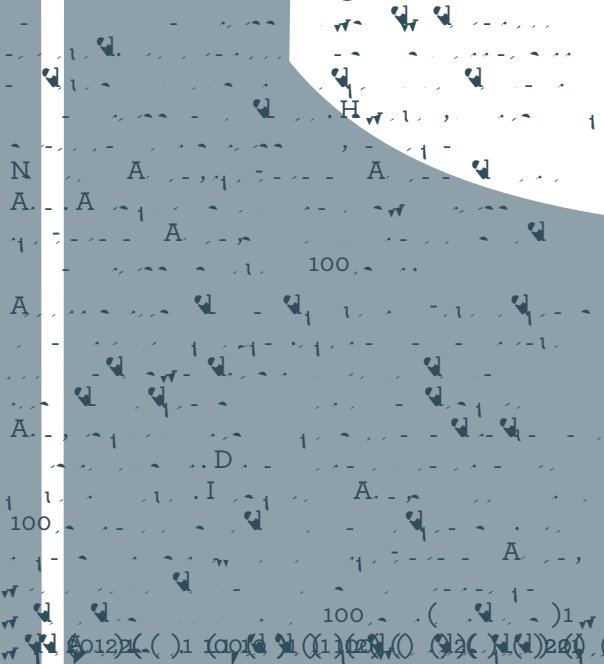
**Target 3.1: Eliminate gender disparity in primary and secondary education, preferably by 2005, and in all levels of education, no later than 2015**

**WHERE WE STAND**

Gender gaps in access to education have narrowed, but disparities remain among regions in all levels of education, particularly for the most excluded and marginalized. Gender parity is not yet achieved in all regions, particularly in sub-Saharan Africa and South Asia.
