Peacebuilding Commission Informal meeting of the Organizational Committee 17 may 2010

Chairperson's Summary of the Discussion

Background

On 17 May 2010, the Organizational Committee of the Peacebuilding Commission (PBC) convened an informal meeting. The PBC Chairperson (labelized by the Vice-Chairperson) presided over the meeting. The agenda for the meeting include delibration items: (1) Annual report of the PBC to the GA and SC: adjustment of the reporting cycle; (2) Report of the Secretary-General on "Women's participation and inclusion in peace beginated planning in the aftermath of conflict": Briefing by PBSO on the progress, Background Paper, Questions/Answers, Discussion; and (3) Other matters.

1. Annual report of the PBC to the GA and SC: adjustment of the reporting cycle

The Chair circulated an information note prior to the meeting in which he presented a proposal by which the PBC's reporting cycle will be align**tective** membership Ongizational Committee and the chairmanship terms, i.e. aligned to the calendar year.
