

**Peacebuilding Commission**  
**Ambassadorial-level meeting on Mozambique**  
**29 March 2023**

Executive summary

On 29 March, the Peacebuilding Commission (PBC) convened its first meeting on Mozambique to hear from stakeholders about good practices and lessons learned in implementing the Maputo Accord for Peace and National Reconciliation and to exchange on the remaining peacebuilding challenges in Mozambique. The President of the Republic of Mozambique underlined national ownership, mutual trust, and dialogue among the key success factors in the peace process, called for international support of current efforts to counter violent extremism and invited a PBC Delegation to Mozambique. Various briefers outlined the human-centered and gender-sensitive Disarmament, Demobilization and Reintegration (DDR) approach as well as the decentralization process, and
