

The World Bank calculates that by 2030, almost half the world's poor will be residing in countries affected by fragility, confict or violence (FCV). Recognising the <u>links between fragility and poverty</u>, the World Bank has massively scaled up its work in fragile settings since 2016 and launched its first <u>Stra</u> <u>Eu</u> t <u>g</u> <u>2016</u> ty

<u>preventing violen</u>t confict by supporting States to tackle root causes and by remaining confict cycle.

The UN-World Bank partnership has deepened in recent years, with joint engagements in nearly 50 countries affected by or working to prevent FCV. This follows 'Member States' request in the 2016 twin resolutions on sustaining peace (A.70/262-S.RES/2282(2016)), reaffrmed in 2020 (A.RES/75/201-S.RES/2558(2020)) and in the Pact for the Future.

The Peacebuilding Support Office has served as <u>UN system focal point on partnership with WB</u> in crisis-affected settings since 2017, under the UN-WB <u>Partnership Fram ework for Crisis-Affected Situations</u> approved by the Secretary-General in that year. Working with UN partners across the system, PBSO's role includes coordinating UN engagement to the UN-WB Steering Committee, providing expert liaison and advisory support to field teams, and supporting knowledge management. Priority contexts include peacekeeping transitions and settings where Governments are seeking support for nationally-legingenteoftscharzendcapacities and alignment of country strategies, inc Fund. Recovery and Peacebuilding Assessments under the tripartite EU-UN-WB partnership are an important tool that help coordinate wider partner support, for example in Mozam bique (2021) and Haiti (2024).

Operational partnerships between the World Bank and UN Agencies help ensure International Development Association (IDA) f nancing reaches the most vulnerable. IDA investment in the FCV settings has more than doubled since 2018 and accounts for a growing share of the bank's overall concessional f nancing. From 1July 2015 to 30 June 2023, \$8.61 billion were channeled through either direct or indirect TPI, according to the FCV Strategy MTR. PBSO is

PBS0 prevention and peacebuilding with other IFIs, including by developing joint workplans and collaborating in country assessments. The Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) Framework to Support Populations in Situations of Fragility, Confict and Criminal Violence: 2024 - 2027, and the Asian Development Bank (ADB), Fragile and Confict-Affected Situations and Small Island Developing States Approach offer exciting opportunities for greater cooperation.
