- 1. On 21 June, the Reacebuilding Commission (PBC) convened its first Ambassadural-level meeting on the 2025 Review of the Reacebuilding Auchitecture. The meeting showcased the support and accompaniment of the Commission to The Gambia since its first engagement in 2017. The meeting was opened with an interactive dialogue, facilitated by the Chair of the Commission, Ambassadur Sérgio Danese, with HE Mr Minadou Tangura, Minister of Foreign A airs of The Gambia, and former Remement Representative of the Gambia to the United Nations, and HE Mr Cho Tae yul, Minister of Foreign A airs of the Republic of Korea, who was Chair of the Commission in 2017, when The Gambia started first to engage with the Commission Ms. Elizabeth Spelar, Assistant Secretary General for Peacebuilding Support also briefed the Commission
