Subject: Results of the election of members of the Security Council General Assembly held on 11 November 1950


Excency,

Reference is made to my journal for yesterday, President of the General Assembly dated 4 November 1950 concerning the election of five members of the International Court of Justice.

As announced in the 373rd meeting held today, 11 November 1950, the secret ballot in the Security Council has concluded, but the secret ballot in the General Assembly was not conclusive. The 373rd meeting of the Security Council has, therefore, been suspended until the General Assembly completes its balloting and procure exactly five candidates.

As soon as I receive from the President of the General Assembly the names of the five candidates who received the required majority, I shall resume the meeting and announce the results of the voting in the Security Council and the General Assembly.
